WHEN: Gates open at 5 p.m. Concerts begin at 6 p.m. rain or shine—no refunds or exchanges.

TICKETS: Tickets go on sale beginning April 25 at 8 a.m. at zoo.org/zootunes and at 8:30 a.m. at the zoo entrances. A \$2 processing fee is added to all online ticket sales.

After April 25, a very limited number of tickets will be available for purchase at Woodland Park Zoo gates during zoo hours. Ticket prices at all outlets will include a \$2 facility fee to fund maintenance of the zoo's concert facilities. One child 12 and under per paid ticket is admitted free. ZooTunes concert-goers can purchase up to eight tickets per show.

Member pre-sale

Woodland Park Zoo members will have the opportunity to purchase ZooTunes tickets before the general public. The ZooTunes member pre-sale begins online only on April 23 at 8:00 a.m. Members will receive an exclusive pre-sale link by email and can purchase up to eight pre-sale tickets per show.

Reserved Seat upgrades

A limited number of Reserved Seat tickets are available for each show. Reserved tickets provide concert-goers with premium seating (chair provided) and special parking. Upgrades must be purchased online at zoo.org/zootunes. Reserved Seat tickets will sell out fast, so purchase early.
