## Pokémon takes over zoo's holiday lights festival yet again

WHAT:

Back by popular demand! Woodland Park Zoo is dropping Pokémon lures across zoo grounds and is calling all trainers to find and catch them all during the return event of Pokémon Night at WildLights presented by Sound Credit Union on Wednesday, December 14, from 5:30-8:30 p.m.
