The new cub was born July 6 and is the first offspring between mom Helen and dad Dhirin (*did-in*), both 12. Helen has had two previous litters with a different mate.

Helen and her cub have been living in an off-view maternity den for bonding and proper nursing in a quieter setting. Zookeepers report the cub is more mobile; he has ventured outside of the den and spends most days playing with mom in the inside bedroom, which is off public view. Starting next week, the unnamed cub will be introduced to solid foods and to the outdoor enclosure that is off view to guests.
