> 10:00 a.m. at zoo.org/zootunes and at zoo gates during zoo hours. A \$4 processing fee per ticket is added to all online ticket sales. Tickets for

previously announced shows are currently on sale.

Ticket prices at all outlets include a \$2 facility fee to fund maintenance of the zoo's concert facilities. One child 12 and under per paid ticket is admitted free. Each free child will require a voucher for admission, which can be printed online with purchased tickets or picked up at purchase locations.



ZooTunes concert-goers can purchase up to eight general admission tickets per show.

Member pre-sale

Woodland Park Zoo members will have the opportunity to purchase all ZooTunes tickets before the general public. The ZooTunes member pre-sale begins online only on April 4 at 10:00 a.m. Members will receive an exclusive pre-sale code by email and can purchase up to eight general admission pre-sale tickets per show.

Reserved seat upgrades

A limited number of Reserved seat tickets are available for each show. Reserved tickets provide concert-goers with premium seating (chair provided) and special parking. Reserved tickets are valid for one entry only regardless of age; there is no additional entry for one child 12 and under with a reserved ticket. Children 12 and under require a separately purchased reserved ticket to access the reserved area.
