**SEATTLE** — As a part of their mission to educate and inspire more engaged stewardship and conservation for our natural environment, especially for the next generation, the Woodland Park Zoo and Seattle Aquarium will announce their endorsement for I-1631 Thursday 10/24. I-1631 would put a fee on the state's largest polluters and invest in making clean energy more affordable and protecting state natural resources.
