### Zoo honors U.S. military and veterans with free zoo admission on Veterans Day, Sunday, November 11



**WHAT:** They serve, they defend, they protect, they sacrifice—and Woodland Park Zoo proudly salutes them. In honor of those who put themselves at risk in service to their community and country, the zoo extends free admission to all active, retired, and veteran U.S. military personnel *and* their spouses with valid service identification on **Veterans Day, Sunday, November 11, 2018**. In addition, up to six family members accompanying heroes with valid ID receive \$4 off admission on Veterans Day.

**WHEN:** Veterans Day discount is valid Sunday, November 11, during zoo hours, 9:30 a.m.–4:00 p.m.

**WHERE:** Admission discounts can be redeemed at zoo admission gates: West Entrance at Phinney Ave. N. between N. 55<sup>th</sup> and N. 56<sup>th</sup> Sts. and South Entrance at N. 50<sup>th</sup> St. and Fremont Ave. N.

**COST:** Veterans Day admission is free to all active, retired, and veteran U.S. military personnel *and* their spouses. Must show valid service ID to redeem discount. Up to four family members accompanying heroes with valid ID receive \$5 off admission on Veterans Day.

#### Ongoing Military Discount

Year round, Woodland Park Zoo offers regular military discounts: active, retired, and veteran U.S. military personnel *or* military spouses receive \$4 off zoo admission when purchased at any zoo gate for themselves and up to six family members. Military personnel *or* military spouses must show valid military ID.

**INFO:** Fall/winter zoo hours October 1 through April 30: 9:30 a.m.–4:00 p.m. daily. Regular zoo admission before discount: Adult (13–64) \$14.95; Child (3–12) \$9.95; Toddler (0–2) Free. Seniors and people with physical disabilities receive an admission discount. Zoo members receive free zoo admission year round. Parking: \$6 plus applicable state and local taxes.

Mobile app: Download the free Woodland Park Zoo mobile app for iPhone, iPad or Android from your app store. Use it to track your location on zoo grounds with GPS, discover more about animals and daily zoo activities, and share the highlights of your visit with friends.

Wi-Fi: Free Wi-Fi is available throughout the zoo for zoo guests, made possible through products donated by Cisco.

Gifts/food: Explore the ZooStores for extraordinary gifts and zoo souvenirs. Stop by the Rain Forest Food Pavilion or other concessionaire locations to quench your thirst or appetite.

Refillable water stations: The sale of single-use plastics for beverages has been eliminated at the zoo. Find refillable water stations throughout the zoo and bring your own reusable bottle or purchase a stainless steel bottle at the ZooStores.
