## Tickets on sale now for Seattle's wildest lights festival 800,000+ lights transform zoo into sparkling winter wonderland



**WHAT:** Come one, come all to Woodland Park Zoo's **WildLights presented by Sound Credit Union!** Grab the whole family and check out more than 800,000 energy-efficient bright and colorful LED lights recreating wild animals and wild places across the zoo. Experience brand new wild and wonderful light displays that will be featured throughout the zoo including a holiday light spectacular at the zoo's South Entrance. It's the biggest and brightest WildLights yet!

While taking in the vivid lights, sights, and sounds of WildLights, enjoy close-up animal encounters, carolers, and Instagrammable moments galore, including a dazzling and towering arch of lights perfect for posing under, glowing and colorful frames, a tunnel of sparkling lights and more! Take a night ride on the festively lit Historic Carousel, or drop by Snowmazium to build a snow creature, hear a snow story or even join a faux snowball fight! Feeling hungry? Lots of warm treats are available across the zoo, such as S'mores, hot donuts, scones, hot chocolate and other tasty selections.

### **NEW! The Bear's Den in the Winter Garden**

Join the fun at The Bear's Den in the Winter Garden, located on the zoo's North Meadow. Guests 21 and over can enjoy a beer and wine garden (ID required), and all ages are invited to play fun games, grab a toasty treat and warm up by the fire pits.

While the zoo's animals will be tucked in for the night, select indoor exhibits will be open to explore, such as the Adaptations Building, home to meerkats and nocturnal animals such as sloths and fruit bats. Get up close and personal with one of the zoo's ambassador animals, which will make appearances throughout WildLights!

South Entrance: 750 N. 50th St., Seattle, WA 98103  
*Cross streets: N. 50th St. and Fremont Ave. N.*

Night-of-event tickets will be sold at the zoo's West and South Entrances, if not sold out. WildLights will be a rain or shine event—there will be no ticket refunds.
