**WHAT:** Get your sparkle on at the biggest and brightest WildLights yet! Experience **WildLights presented by Sound Credit Union** before the eighth annual winter lights festival opens to the public. All media are invited to a press preview on **Tuesday, November 26, 5:30–7:00 p.m.**

Check out more than 800,000 energy-efficient bright and colorful LED lights transforming the zoo into a wild winter wonderland. Experience brand new magical light displays throughout the zoo including a holiday light spectacular at the zoo's South Entrance.

While taking in the vivid lights, sights, and sounds of WildLights, enjoy close-up animal encounters, carolers, and Instagrammable moments galore, including a dazzling and towering arch of lights perfect for posing under, glowing and colorful frames, a tunnel of sparkling lights and more! Take a night ride on the festively lit Historic Carousel, or drop by Snowmazium to build a snow creature, hear a snow story or even join a faux snowball fight! Feeling hungry? Lots of warm treats are available across the zoo, such as S'mores, hot donuts, scones, hot chocolate and other tasty selections.

**WHEN:** **WildLights press preview: Tuesday, November 26, 5:30–7:00 p.m.**

The illuminating, after-hours event begins for the general public Friday, November 29, 2019, through Sunday, January 5, 2020, 5:30–8:30 p.m. WildLights will be closed December 2, 3, 9, 10, 24 and 25.

**WHERE:** Meet PR staff at the West Entrance at Phinney Ave. N. between N. 55th & N. 56th Sts. Park in the Penguin Lot at N. 55th St. & Phinney Ave. N. or Otter Lot off N. 59th St. & Phinney Ave. N. Parking is free.

**COST:** Media gets complimentary admission to WildLights during the press preview on November 26.

WildLights tickets are on sale now, and can be purchased online by visiting [zoo.org/wildlights](http://zoo.org/wildlights) or at zoo gates during regular zoo hours. Night-of-event tickets will be sold at the zoo's West and South Entrances, if not sold out. WildLights will be a rain or shine event--there will be no ticket refunds.
