The **gray wolf** is a highly social pack animal. Wolves can thrive in a variety of habitats from the tundra to woodlands, forests, grasslands and deserts. At one time, wolves were widespread across most of North America and Eurasia. Today, the wolf is making a successful comeback in some of its former habitat due to strong conservation efforts.



To carve your pumpkin:

1. Print out the template below (resize if needed).
2. Tape the template onto your pumpkin.
3. Trace the design by poking small holes along the edges of the shapes using a pen or awl.
4. Cut along the edges of the shapes with a carving tool.
