

TIGER PUMPKIN CARVING

Tigers are big, powerful cats with sharp teeth and lean, muscular bodies. Their stripes are like fingerprints in that no two tigers have the same pattern. Tigers used to live across much of Asia, but all subspecies are now endangered from habitat loss, illegal palm oil plantations and poaching. - 3. Trace the design by poking small holes along the edges of the shapes using a pen or awl.
- 4. Cut along the edges of the shapes with a carving tool.
