INFO: As an infant, Nadiri was partly hand-reared. She didn't immediately pick up her newborn to nurse or keep her warm enough the first day. Shortly after birth, gorilla and veterinary staff stepped in to provide round-the-clock care for the baby including bottle feeding her human infant formula, keeping her warm and providing her with short visits with her mother. Since those introduction sessions, the baby is now with mom full-time and she has started to nurse, but continues to be supplementally bottle-fed by the gorilla keepers.

The new baby girl is a half-sister for both little Kitoko born last March and 5year-old Yola, who is Nadiri's first-born. She doesn't have a name yet but will be named soon.
