Zoo honors U.S. military and veterans with free admission on Veterans Day, November 11

WHAT: They serve, they defend, they protect, they sacrifice—and Woodland Park Zoo proudly salutes them. In honor of those who offer service to their community and country, the zoo extends free admission to all active, retired, reserve, and veteran U.S. military personnel *and* their spouses on Veterans Day, Thursday, November 11.

In addition, up to six family members accompanying heroes with valid ID will receive \$3 off admission on Veterans Day.

WHEN: Veterans Day discount is valid Thursday, November 11, 9:30 a.m.–4:00 p.m. with valid service identification.

WHERE: Admission discounts can be redeemed at the zoo's West Entrance at Phinney Ave. N. between N. 55th and N. 56th Sts. and South Entrance at N. 50th St. and Fremont Ave. N.

COST: Veterans Day admission is free to all active, retired, and veteran U.S. military personnel *and* their spouses. Must show valid service ID to redeem discount.

Regular zoo admission before discount: Adult (13–64) \$17.00; Senior (65+) \$15.00; Child (3–12) \$11.50; Toddler (0–2) Free. Discount for people with disabilities: \$2 off regular admission; 1:1 aides are complimentary.

Year-round Military Discount

Available at any zoo entrance or online: Active, retired, reserve, and veteran U.S. military personnel or military spouses receive \$3 off zoo admission year round for themselves and up to six family members. Military personnel or military spouses must show valid military ID.

Parking: \$6 first two hours, \$2 each additional hour plus applicable state and local taxes.
