HERE'S WHAT YOU CAN DO!

- **Learn to love the shrub steppe – join a guided nature hike with a local nature organization**
- **Protect and restore western North America's shrub steppe landscapes – volunteer for restoration events with a local land trust or Conservation District**
- **Protect key prey populations such as ground squirrels and other small mammals – avoid use of rodenticides and other pesticides**
- **Be a responsible sportsperson and switch to non-lead ammunition and tackle for hunting and fishing**
