COST: Mom & Me is free with zoo admission. Moms get half price off zoo admission on Saturday, May 11. Admission May 1-September 30: Adult (13-64) \$18.75; Child (3-12) \$11.75; Toddler (0-2) Free. Active, retired, and veteran U.S. military and their families, seniors and people with physical disabilities receive an admission discount. Zoo members receive free zoo admission year round.
